Macramé Plant Hanger

Kit contains:

- 1 metal hook
- 1 small terra cotta pot
- Bundle of yarn
- Written instructions

Visit our YouTube channel to find a video demonstration for making the Macramé Plant Hanger.

1. Gather the yarn strands and fold in half, then loop the folded end through the ring. Pull the loose ends through the loop of yarn and pull taut.
2. Separate the strands of yarn into 4 groups of two.
3. Measure out several inches and tie each separate group together. Make sure the knots are roughly the same length. I like to use the top of the pot as a guide for how far down the knots should be.
4. Take a strand from the left and right of each group and tie them together. Tie the knots a little higher up, only an inch from the first set of knots. Tie the outermost strands last.
5. Tie one more round of knots, repeating the process of knotting the left and right strand of each group.
6. Tie all the strands in a knot about an inch below the last round of knots.
7. Cut off excess yarn and insert the terra cotta pot.

Now all you need is a plant! Enjoy!
