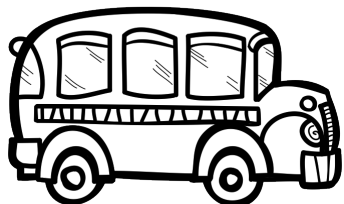
# Story Times with Miss Karen
