Check out our WiFi kits!

Manlius Library provides patrons with circulating Chromebooks and hotspots. If you don't have the internet at home, this is the opportunity to get wireless independence.

Patrons can check out a Chromebook laptop and accompanying 4G wireless internet hotspot for three weeks. These hotspots allow up to 10 different devices to connect to the Internet for free.

These kits are loaned to patrons aged 18 and older with library cards in good standing. Kits are not available for immediate checkout; patrons must complete a training session with a library staff member and sign a loan agreement prior to checkout.
