Take a family field trip!

We offer a selection of passes for Manlius Library cardholders to visit local parks and other attractions free of charge! Passes must be picked up in person during Manlius Library's open hours and cannot be held or reserved. Passes typically circulate for three days and carry a \$1 per day late fine. Passes we offer:

Empire Passes: We have three Empire Passes for unlimited day-use vehicle entry to any New York State Park, including Green Lakes State Park, Clark Reservation State Park, and Chittenango Falls State Park.

Everson Museum Family Pass: The Everson Museum Family Pass allows complimentary museum admission for up to 2 adults and 2 children. This pass can also be used at reciprocal EMPIRE State museums.

MOST Pass: The MOST Pass allows admission for up to 6 people per visit, plus a discount in the Museum Shop and more.

Onondaga County Parks Pass: We have two Onondaga County Parks passes, good for free admission into county parks including:

- Beaver Lake Nature Center (one vehicle)
- Highland Forest (up to four visitors)
- Jamesville Beach Park (one personal vehicle)
- Oneida Shores Park (one personal vehicle)
- Pratt's Falls Park (up to four visitors)
- Rosamond Gifford Zoo (up to four visitors)
